



### Key figures and history of the uB



- Created in 1722
- Creation of the Dijon campus in 1957
- 30,000 students amongst whom 2,300 are international students
- 1,000 PhD students amongst whom 350 are international students
- 6,400 employees: administrative staff, teaching staff, researchers...
- 2015: uB became part of the Community of the University Burgundy Franche-Comté with 55,000 students

### **Learning French at uB**

#### International centre for French studies (CIEF)

- Semester courses

### Study at the uB

#### **Degree seeking students**

- A good level of French is required for French taught programmes: C1 for study programs in Law, Economics, Administration and Life, Earth and Environmental Sciences; B2 for all other fields of study
- Language diploma required: TCF, DELF or DALF
- Application procedure: between November and April

#### **Exchange students**

- Application deadline: 15<sup>th</sup> November for summer semester, 15<sup>th</sup> May for winter semester and whole year students
- Students can apply for a room in student residences
- → Detailed information can be found at the <u>Admission website</u>.





### **Student residences on campus**

- Basic room: from 160 euros/month
- Comfort room: from 245 euros/month
- Studio: from 320 euros/month
- Apartments: from 245 euros/month (18m²) to 845 euros/month (60m²)
- Rooms, studios and apartments suitable for people with reduced mobility
- → Possibility to obtain the State's financial aid for housing



### Research



- 27 research units
- 85 million € dedicated to research activity, including salary mass
- 1, 000 PhD students in 6 doctoral schools
- Research activity in connection with the city
- Experimentarium, European Researcher's Night: science for everybody
- International house: high-quality housing for researchers

### Wine culture and tradition: a key topic at uB

- A dedicated teaching structure providing French degrees in Oenology
- Wine experimentation and production in our own AOC (protected designation of origin) vineyard
- Cross-sectional research on wine
- Officially recognized as the only UNESCO Chair "Culture and traditions of wine"
