



Welcome days for international students 2022/2023

Guided tour of the Dijon campus

You will discover the most useful places and facilities for your student life - libraries, restaurants, Health centre, free sport activities, how to get a discount card for cultural events, which student support organisations exist... It will also allow you to meet other international students.

Who can participate? It is open and free for all international students of the University of Burgundy.

In which language will the visit take place? In French or in English. Or simultaneously in two languages, depending on the language skills of the participants.

Where will the tour take place? The meeting point is in front of the Maison de l'étudiant ([building 22 on the campus map](#)). A person from the International office will be waiting for you in front of the building with a small European flag in its hand.

When the visit takes place? One visit per week is organised throughout September. No need to register - just come along on a date that suits you.

- Thursday 1 September at 11am.
- Thursday 8 September at 2pm.
- Thursday 15 September at 4pm.
- Thursday 22 September at 6pm.
- Friday 30 September at 7pm.

Duration? Approximately 2 hours or more if the visit is done simultaneously in two languages.

Festive evening for international students

Have fun, meet other international students who have just arrived in France, get to know French students, taste local specialties and dance if you wish!

Who can participate? It is free and open to all international students newly arrived at the University of Burgundy. No need to register in advance but be aware that the number of places is limited - priority will be given to the first comers.

Where and when? In the Multiplex building ([building 57 on the campus map](#)) on Friday, September 16 from 7 p.m.

International office information stall

As part of the *Campus Days* events that take place in September for all students of the University of Burgundy, the International office will have an information stall.

You will be able to discuss with the members of the International office if you have specific questions. If you are registered at the University of Burgundy as degree-seeking students, we can also inform you about the possibilities of going abroad as part of an exchange programme (Erasmus+, BCI in Quebec, FORTHEM Alliance...) or internship as well as financial aids dedicated to international mobility.

Who can come to the stall? All students, international and French. It's free and you don't need to register to come to the stall.

Where and when? On the Esplanade Erasme (near the Droit-Lettres library - [building 24 on the campus map](#)) on Thursday, September 29 during the day.

How to participate?

1. After your administrative registration at the University of Burgundy, [activate your electronic student account](#).

2. Install the TEAMS platform for free ([Office 365 license and TEAMS installation tutorial](#) in French only).
3. Join the [group of international students on TEAMS](#) where the information meeting will take place and where you can discuss throughout the year with the members of the International office and other international students.
4. Log in to the meeting on October 6 a little bit before 12:30 p.m. [via this link](#).
